- ExtraNet is a managed extension of Intranet
- Notes databases hosted on "Domino" server
- ExtraNet user (member) access via browser
- Upload/Download common office file types



- Member Surveys/Feedback (one-to-many)
- WorkGroup/Committee transactional steps
- Issue Resolution (workflow & consensus)
- Responsive and Rapid Public Relations
- Publish Conference Proceedings On-Line



- Readily managed Distribution Lists per Issue
- Survey Forms offered with Notes templates
- Available Tools for Rapid Survey Analyses
- Couple with "Notes E-Mail" for Follow-up



# Work Groups & Committees

- Chairpersons could directly manage access
- Ideal for draft document review & response
- Resolve which documents public/which not
- Audit trail if required to satisfy "discovery"

- Applicable to Hill Legislative Initiatives
- Applicable to Regulatory Development
- Applicable to Economic Case Studies
- Applicable to Document Trail of Filings



### Public Relations Tool

- "Mail-Enabled" Internal Approval Routing
- Immediate On-Line Publishing Capability (absolutely no web programming required)
- Public Feedback Tools (E-Mail, CheckOff)
- Readily Link to On-Line Resource Library
